Dear members and Friends of Shamayita Math

Let me start by mentioning the two biggest events this year.

On 2. February at the Grønnemoseskolen in Gladsaxe, members of the Indian community in the Copenhagen area had arranged a big Indian song and music event with several hundred participants.

The Theme was A JOURNEY THROUGH THE GOLDEN ERA with popular songs by R. D. Burman, who has written songs and music to more than 300 movies. The singers had rehearsed thoroughly and sang with bravura for an enthusiastic audience. Children from Deepshikha's dance school also performed with beautiful dances. We didn't have to go hungry since there was a big Indian buffet with many items. The organizers had decided the surplus from the event - appr. 4.800 DKK - should be donated to Friends of Shamayita Math. We are very grateful for that. We also used the event to inform about Friends of Shamayita Math and we got a few new members.

Our traditional summer event took place on 26. May in Anirudh's and Deepshikha's garden in Lyngby. The main attraction was again Deep's Dancing Divas and also children from other dance schools.

All the children were dressed in beautiful Indian dresses and performed the dances with charm and enthusiasm. I can understand their parents were proud of them. There were also great singing and dances from more grown up performers. Bente Hagelund had a visitor from West Bengal, her friend Madhumitha Bisnu. She is involved in supporting Shamayita Math and she told us about recent developments at Shamayita Math, amongst other things the building of a large new convent school for boys. The social work at Shamayita Math began years ago by the construction of a large convent school for girls, because it was difficult for girls to get a school education in that part of India. But the locals have wanted a convent school for boys, so the boys

Last year, we had brilliant weather at the summer event, but this year the weather was not with us, so we had to borrow a big tent and buy some covers. Although we had a few showers it was possible to carry out the event. I want to thank all who helped with the tents.

We had appr. 110 adults and 70 children to the event and we had a surplus of appr. 6.000 DKR. Thanks to Anirudh and Deepskikha for hosting the event.

It is really good that so many people attend and support. However, it is a challenge to have so many people in a private garden. So next year we will try to find another venue. Maybe at a school. We plan to have the event on Sunday 17 May 2020, so please reserve that day.

The money we collect is primarily send to the village school we financed in Darangpara: to running expenses, educational equipment, school uniforms and a daily hot meal. But you can also help by becoming a sponsor for a child in the school, which I think is a joy. The boy I have sponsored, Sanjit, has now grown out of the village school, and have advanced to a public school for bigger children some distance from the village. Shamayita Math has allocated another boy I can sponsor, Sudip, 8 years old.

Presently, we have arranged 8 sponsorships for children from the village school. The cost is 700 DKK a year. There is one sponsor for a student in the convent school. The cost here is 3.700 DKK.
